Anti-Bullying Week 2017

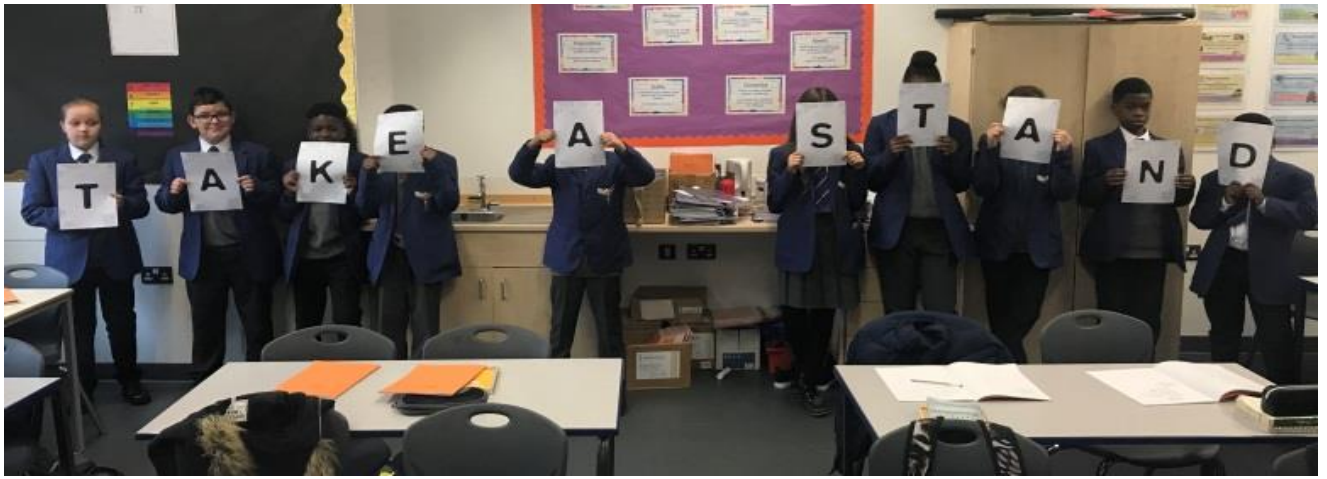
