YOUNGSTERS gathered in silence to remember the sacrifice of Armed Forces servicemen and women.

Kids at Stockwell Park High School in
Stockwell Park Road observed a twominute silence on Friday morning before
marching to the Stockwell War Memorial.

The memorial was built in 1922 and lists the names of 574 local men who lost their lives in the First World War. The school's director of administration, Dr Chun Yu Lok, said: "The young people of today will shape our society of tomorrow and this is our additional

focus on Remembrance Day.
