# **Anti-Bullying Workshop**

#### Portfolio for Learning

Year 7 pupils started their Portfolio for Life this week. This is designed to meet the needs of our school community and ensure that we deliver the statutory PSHE and RSE curriculum.

Portfolio for Life lessons develop pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural skills. Pupils study a range of topics in these lessons such as Health and Wellbeing, Relationships and Living in the Wider World. In Portfolio for Life lessons, pupils learn a range of skills which directly relate to the world of business. As a Business and Enterprise school, we encourage our pupils to value and practice enterprise in all its forms. This is a course designed to develop the skills and attitudes pupils need to prepare them for their future success in life and work.

Pupils receive certificates for their work in Portfolio for Life lessons termly. They also receive certificates for wider contributions to the school community. This includes participation in clubs and partaking in wider school programmes such as the leadership programme. Pupils will be given a 'Record of Achievement' folder to place their certificates in. Year 7 have received their record of achievement this week

and have begun working towards their first certificate in Portfolio for Life lessons.

Year 7 pupils begin by focusing on 'Well-being'. They started the week with a transition programme designed to help them familiarise themselves with Platanos College and with their new teachers and peers. Over the course of this term, pupils will learn more about the school community and learn about the importance of skills such as resilience.

It has been an excellent start for Year 7s in Portfolio for Life lessons and we look forward to celebrating their successes in the subject over the course of the academic year!
