

## Pathway 1 Advanced Level

## Subjects at Advanced Level

### **Biology**

Biology is the scientific study of living organisms and how they interact with each other and their environments.

## Chemistry

Chemistry is the scientific study of how substances behave: how and why they combine or separate to form other substances and how matter interacts with energy.

## **Physics**

Physics is the scientific study of the laws that govern our Universe from the smallest subatomic particles to the Universe itself. A range of topics including energy, forces, electricity, particle physics, nuclear physics and quantum physics are all covered.

#### **Mathematics**

Mathematics is not simply about calculations at A level. A more demanding subject than GCSE Maths, A level is a rigorous subject requiring clear thinking and hard work. Students learn about Geometry, Calculus, Trigonometry, Mechanics and Statistics.


## **English Literature**

This is the study and appreciation of all forms of literature including poetry, novels and plays.

#### Law

This course is about understanding the role of law in today's society. Students learn about the nature of law, the English legal system, private law, public law and legal skills.

## Subjects at Advanced Level

## **Sociology**

This is the study of people, their values, attitudes, culture and the organisation of society.

## **History**

The study of the past - of people, events, places and other times. Students will be researching evidence, asking questions and forming explanations.

#### **Business Studies**

This is the study of how businesses operate. Students learn about marketing, finance, operations, strategy, human resources, leadership and management.

## **Psychology**

Psychology is the scientific study of human behaviour and experience. It seeks to explain how our minds work.

#### **Economics**

This subject covers the market system, market failure and government intervention, the national and international economy, the economics of work and leisure, the UK economy and the global context.



# Pathway 2 Creative and performing arts and digital media

(With effect from September 2024 for Year 12)

## Introduction

BTEC courses are flexible and can be studied alongside GCSEs. BTECs contain a mixture of core and optional units with lots of opportunities to build on your digital media skills with exciting practical projects such as film-making and other aspects of media production.

Students with a BTEC qualification in Creative Digital Media Production would be able to use their skills in photography, editing, sound recording, web design, games design, digital animation, graphics, mobile app development and website development. Employment opportunities exist such as audio, digital re-mastering and post-production engineering, studio set-up and management, sound technician, acoustic consultant, recording equipment customer service, recording mixer, interactive and mixed media specialists, music editing, programming, sound design, remixing, audio development for apps and video games.

BTEC First courses provide good, flexible foundations and are equivalent to GCSEs.

**BTEC National** courses are the equivalent of A levels and are accepted by many universities. Entry requirements are five GCSEs at grade 4 or above.

**BTEC Apprenticeships** involve practical approaches and work experience.

## Pathway 3 Vocational

(With effect from September 2024 for Year 12)

The Vocational Pathway offers students great flexibility in the programme of subjects that they can study and is very tailored to their individual needs.

GCSEs can be studied alongside BTEC qualifications.

Online study can widen the range of subjects on offer.


The Sporting Pathway will be tailored to offer a range of sports in addition to Sports-related level 3 (A-level equivalent) courses. There will be an offer of practical sports sessions with a focus on leadership skills, discipline and skills.
